## Music

This activity accompanies chapter 3 from *The Autobiography of an Ex-Colored Man* by James Weldon Johnson, record number 1753.

**Activity Title:** Music

**Description:** The students will explain how the main character is affected by music in various ways.

**Subject:** Reading/Language Arts

**Skill:** Literary Analysis

## **Behavioral Objective:**

• The student will explain how the main character is influenced by music throughout the chapter.

## **Materials:**

## **Procedures:**

Read the chapter with the class, or have the students read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main events of the chapter. Next, have the students work with a partner or small group to discuss the significance of music on the main character. When the students have finished discussing, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.
