## **Compare and Contrast**

This activity accompanies chapter 6 from *Uncle Tom's Cabin* as told to children by Harriet Beecher Stowe, told by H.E. Marshal, record number 4861.

**Activity Title:** Compare and Contrast

**Description:** The students will compare and contrast how Uncle Tom and little Harry left the Shelby house.

**Subject:** Reading/Language Arts

**Skill:** Compare and Contrast

### **Behavioral Objective:**

• The student will compare and contrast Uncle Tom leaving with little Harry leaving.

#### **Materials:**



- Paper and pencils
- Venn diagram template (below)

#### **Procedures:**

Read the sixth chapter of *Uncle Tom's Cabin* or have the students read it on their own. Discuss with the students that both little Harry and Uncle Tom ended up leaving the Shelby's home. Have the students work with a partner to compare and contrast little Harry leaving and Uncle Tom leaving, using the Venn diagram (template below). Share the Venn diagrams with the class.
