

The Reunion

This activity accompanies chapter 9 from *Uncle Tom's Cabin* as told to children by Harriet Beecher Stowe, told by H.E. Marshal, record number 4864.

Activity Title: The Reunion

Description: The students will write about a time when they were reunited with someone they had not seen in a long time.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Writing

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will write a text-to-self connection relating to chapter nine of *Uncle Tom's Cabin*.

Materials:

- *Uncle Tom's Cabin*, chapter 9, available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Pencils and paper

Procedures:

Read the ninth chapter of *Uncle Tom's Cabin* or have the students read it on their own. Discuss with the students how Eliza must feel now that she is back together with her husband, who she has not seen for a long time. Have the students write about a time when they reunited with someone that they had not seen for a long time. If there is time, have the students illustrate their story. Next, have the students share their stories with a partner.
