This activity accompanies chapter 14 from *Uncle Tom's Cabin* as told to children by Harriet Beecher Stowe, told by H.E. Marshal, record number 4869.

Activity Title: Aunt Dinah's Messy Kitchen

Description: The students will complete a cause and effect chart telling why Aunt Dinah's kitchen is messy.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Cause and Effect

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will identify cause and effect in the chapter.

Materials:

- *Uncle Tom's Cabin*, chapter 14, available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Pencils and paper
- Cause and effect template (below)

Procedures:

Read the fourteenth chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. In this chapter Miss Ophelia begins to straighten up the house and attempts to straighten up the kitchen. Aunt Dinah keeps things a bit messy in the kitchen. Have the students complete the sentences below to explain why Aunt Dinah cannot do certain things. For example, she cannot mix the biscuits on the pastry table because it gets so full of dishes.
