Activity Title: Problems and Solutions

Description: The students will identify two problems and their solutions from the chapter.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Problem/Solution

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will identify the problem and solution in the chapter.

Procedures:

Read the sixteenth chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. In this chapter, Eva falls ill and has a talk with Topsy about her behavior. Discuss with the students the summary of events of the chapter. Then, have the students write two problems from the chapter and their solutions.

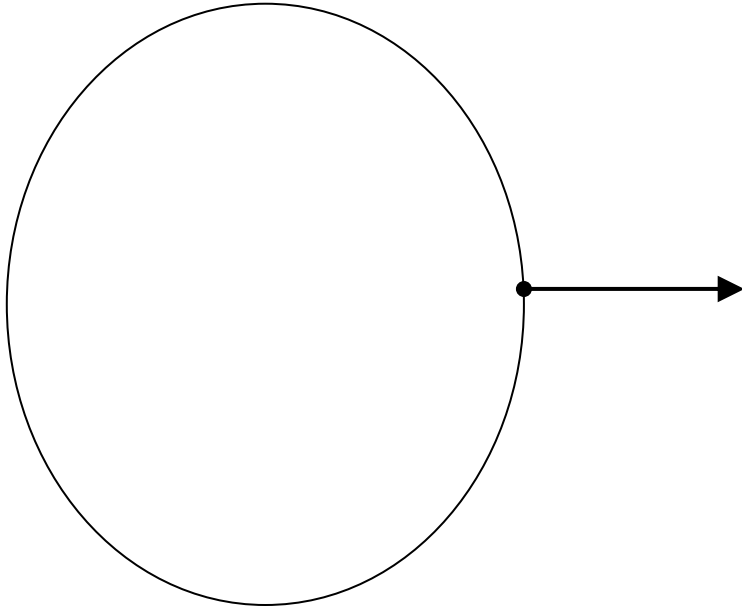


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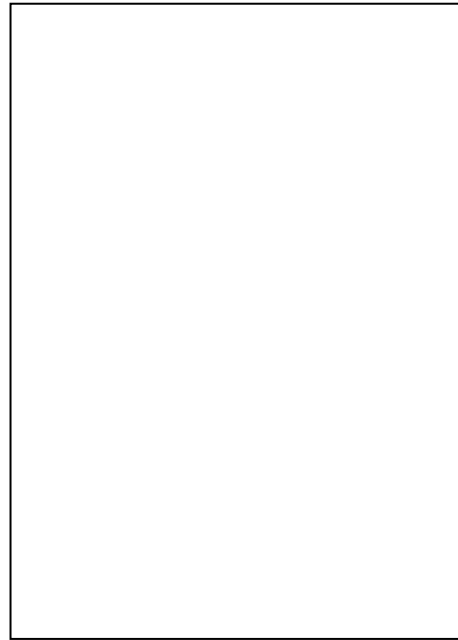

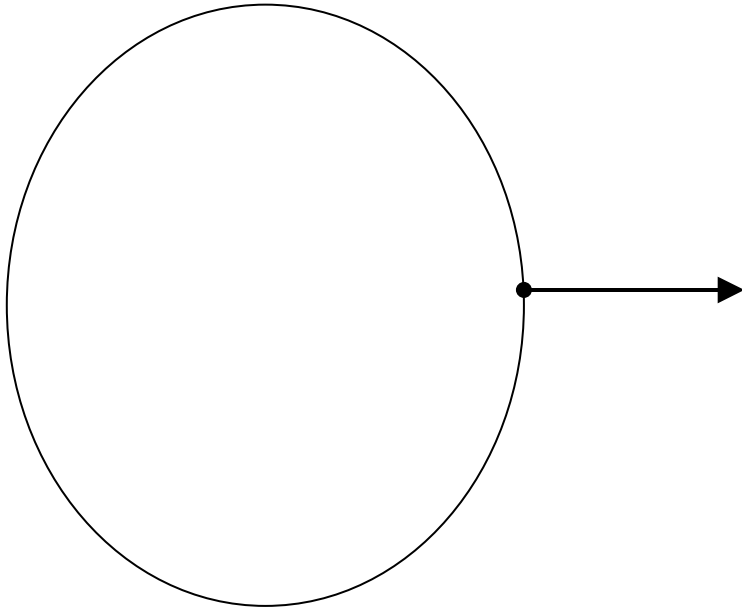
