### **Thomas Loker**

This activity accompanies chapter 19 from *Uncle Tom's Cabin* as told to children by Harriet Beecher Stowe, told by H.E. Marshal, record number 4874.

**Activity Title:** Thomas Loker

**Description:** The students will compare and contrast the character of Thomas Loker from the beginning to the end of the story.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

**Skill:** Compare and Contrast

## **Behavioral Objective:**

• The student will compare and contrast Thomas Loker's character the first time and the second time we meet him.

#### **Materials:**

- Compare and Contrast chart (below)

#### **Procedures:**

Read the nineteenth chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. In the beginning of this chapter, Thomas Loker is talking with one of the Quaker ladies. Have the students think back to when they first meet Thomas Loker and how he acted compared to how he is acting in this chapter. Have the students work individually, or in pairs, to complete the compare and contrast chart (below) on Thomas Loker.
