Activity Title: Performing a Story

Description: The students will practice and perform the dialogue in this story.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Communication

Behavioral Objective:

• The student will perform the dialogue found in chapter six with a partner.

Materials:

• The Heart of Happy Hollow, Six: The Race Question (copies for each student), available in audio and print form at http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/

Procedures:

Read the sixth chapter of *The Heart of Happy Hollow* or have the students read it on their own. Discuss with the students the dialogue of the chapter and the main idea. Pair students up with a partner and assign each pair a portion of the chapter to practice and perform in front of the class. Have each group take turns performing in front of the class (in chronological order).
