## **Character Map**

This activity accompanies chapter 11 from *The Heart of Happy Hollow* by Paul Laurence Dunbar, record number 4962.

**Activity Title:** Character Map

**Description:** The students will choose one character to analyze, including personality characteristics, and provide proof of those characteristics from the story.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Character Mapping

### **Behavioral Objective:**

• The student will explain and justify the personality characteristics of one of the characters from the story.

#### **Materials:**

- The Heart of Happy Hollow, Eleven: The Triumph of Ol' Mis' Pease, available in audio and print form at <a href="http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/">http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/</a>
- Paper and pencils
- Character map (below)

#### **Procedures:**

Read the eleventh chapter of *The Heart of Happy Hollow* or have the students read it on their own. Discuss with the class the main events and characters of the story. Have the students choose a character from the story and create a character map (below). Make sure they include personality characteristics and evidence justifying those characteristics.
