Main Idea and Title Chart

Activity Title: Main Idea and Title Chart

Description: The students will find and write out the main idea of the story, its supporting details, and ideas about what the title may mean.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Main Idea

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will explain the main idea of the story.
- The student will analyze the meaning of the title of the story.

Materials:

- *The Heart of Happy Hollow, Thirteen:* Schwalliger's Philanthropy, available in audio and print form at http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/
- Paper and pencils
- Main Idea chart (below)

Procedures:

Read the thirteenth chapter of *The Heart of Happy Hollow* or have the students read it on their own. Discuss with the class the main events and how the title relates to the story. Next, have the students fill out the main idea chart (below) and share their findings with a partner.
