## A Story's Time Period

This activity accompanies chapter 15 from *The Heart of Happy Hollow* by Paul Laurence Dunbar, record number 4966.

Activity Title: A Story's Time Period

**Description:** The students will look at the values and themes in the story and how they reflect the time period when the story was written.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

**Skill:** Literary Analysis

## **Behavioral Objective:**

• The student will explain how ideas, values, and themes of the story reflect the historical period in which it was written.

## **Materials:**

- *The Heart of Happy Hollow, Fifteen:* The Home-coming of 'Rastus Smith, available in audio and print form at <a href="http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/">http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/</a>
- Paper and pencils

## **Procedures:**

Read the fifteenth chapter of *The Heart of Happy Hollow* or have the students read it on their own. Discuss with the students the time period in which this story was written. Have the students work with a partner to analyze the story for values, themes, and other literary elements that reflect the time period in which the story was written. When the students have finished working, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.
