Activity Title: Literary Analysis

Description: The students will work in small groups to discuss why the Count of Monte Cristo refuses Cavalcanti's request to have him walked down to the alter.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Literary Analysis

Behavioral Objective:

• The student will discuss why the Count of Monte Cristo refuses Cavalcanti's request to have him walked down to the alter.

Materials:

- The Count of Monte Cristo, chapter 96, available in audio and print form at http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/
- Paper and pencils

Procedures:

Read the chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Then, have the students work in small groups to discuss why the Count of Monte Cristo refuses Cavalcanti's request to have him walked down to the alter at his upcoming wedding. Have the students included textual support in their answers. When the students have finished working, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.
