This activity accompanies chapters 102 and 103 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5604.

Activity Title: The Count Interfering

Description: The students will work in small groups to discuss how the Count of Monte Cristo is interfering.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Literary Analysis

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will discuss how the Count of Monte Cristo is interfering.

Materials:

- *The Count of Monte Cristo*, chapters 102 and 103, available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Paper and pencils

Procedures:

Read the chapters with the students, or have them read them on their own. Discuss with the students the main ideas of the chapters. Then, have the students work in small groups to discuss how the Count of Monte Cristo is interfering with the people around him. Have the students include textual support in their answers. When the students have finished discussing, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.



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
