# **Common Words, Uncommon Meanings**

Activity Title: Common Words, Uncommon Meanings

**Description:** The students will explain the meanings of common words with uncommon meanings, as used in the poem.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Vocabulary

#### **Behavioral Objective:**

• The student will explain the meanings of common words used in an uncommon way in the poem.

### Materials:

- "One Life" poem, available in audio and print form at <u>http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/</u>
- Paper and pencil
- Vocabulary sheet (below)

#### **Procedures:**

Read the poem with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the poem. Next, have the students work individually to complete the vocabulary sheet (below). Then, review the answers to the vocabulary sheet with the students in a group discussion format.

Uncommon definitions for the words as used in the poem:

Smart: to be the source of sharp, local, and usually superficial pain

Pregnant: full of meaning; highly significant; of great importance or potential
