## **Punctuation**

This activity accompanies "Mortality," from *The Complete Poems of Paul Laurence Dunbar* by Paul Laurence Dunbar, record number 5100.

**Activity Title:** Punctuation

**Description:** The students will analyze how the punctuation of the poem adds to its meaning.

**Subject:** Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Literary Analysis

## **Behavioral Objective:**

• The student will work with a partner to analyze how the punctuation in the poem adds to its meaning.

## **Materials:**

- "Mortality" poem, available in audio and print form at <a href="http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/">http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/</a>
- Paper and pencil

## **Procedures:**

Read the poem with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the poem. Then, have the students work with a partner to analyze the poem's punctuation, and write an explanation for how the punctuation enhances the poem's meaning. When the students are finished, review their answers as a class.
