Activity Title: Compare and Contrast

Description: The students will compare and contrast “Dream Song II” and “Dream Song I.”

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Compare and Contrast

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will compare and contrast “Dream Song II” and “Dream Song I.”

Materials:

- “Dream Song II” poem and “Dream Song I”, available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Paper and pencil
- Venn diagram (below)

Procedures:

Read the poems with the students, or have them read them on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the poem. Then, have the students work individually to compare and contrast “Dream Song II” and “Dream Song I.” When the students are finished, have them share what they wrote with a partner.
