

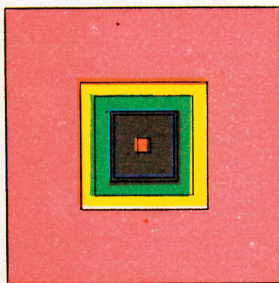

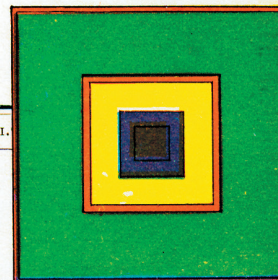
POPULATION.
