# **Color Blindness Simulations**

Vischeck and the Colorblind Web Page Filter are two websites you can use to check the accessibility of your web pages for people who are color blind.

To check a web page with Vischeck:

- 1. Visit <a href="http://www.vischeck.com/vischeck/">http://www.vischeck.com/vischeck/</a> and select "Run Vischeck on a web page."
- 2. Select the type of color blindness you want to simulate at the top of the page.

# Try Vischeck on a Webpage Select the type of color vision to simulate: O Deuteranope (a form of red/green color deficit) O Protanope (another form of red/green color deficit) Tritanope (a blue/yellow deficit- very rare) Enter the URL of any webpage- eg. <a href="www.google.com">www.google.com</a>. URL: Run Vischeck!

3. Enter the web address of the web page you want to check and select Run Vischeck!

# Try Vischeck on a Webpage

### Select the type of color vision to simulate:



Deuteranope (a form of red/green color deficit)



Protanope (another form of red/green color deficit)



Tritanope (a blue/yellow deficit- very rare)

Enter the URL of any webpage- eg. www.google.com.



URL: http://www.apple.com



4. On the results page, click on the link for the simulation you selected. This will show you the web page as it would appear to a person with the type of color blindness you selected.

To check a web page with the Colorblind Web Page Filter:

- 1. Visit <a href="http://colorfilter.wickline.org/">http://colorfilter.wickline.org/</a>.
- 2. Enter the web address of a website you want to check in the Type a URL text box.



3. Select the type of color blindness you want to simulate from the pull down menu.

4. Choose "Fetch and Filter."

After a few seconds, you should see the website open with the colors as they would appear to someone who has the type of color blindness you selected.
