



Maintenance Fee Agreement

Students and families are expected to take care of the laptops and follow all usage guidelines at school and at home. If a student is careless in using the laptop, he or she may lose the privilege of having an assigned laptop.

Damage to the laptops caused by accidents is NOT covered under the manufacturer warranty; however, accidents will happen, and so a fund must be established to cover non-warranted repairs. All students must pay the maintenance fee as a condition for using the laptops at home. The **\$35.00** non-refundable fee must be paid annually. Please make checks payable to the school the student is attending.

Any damage believed by school administrators to have been caused deliberately will be classified as vandalism. Students will be billed in full for repairs caused by vandalism, and disciplinary action, including exclusion from the use of laptop computers, may result.

Since the \$35.00 maintenance fee is not sufficient to cover all repair costs, students will be asked to pay approximately half of the repair costs resulting from accidental damage. The maintenance fee collected from all students will pay for the rest of the repair cost. Listed below are examples of some of these charges:

Damage	Total Repair Cost	Student Responsibility
Broken Display/Screen	\$280	\$140
Broken Keyboard	\$40	\$20
Broken Power Supply	\$40	\$20
Cracked Case	\$60	\$30
Battery	\$70	\$35

Lost or Stolen Equipment

The student must pay **in full** for any equipment issued to them that is lost. The following is a list of replacement costs.

Laptop	\$1100.00
Power Supply	\$40.00
Laptop Case	\$10.00

If a laptop is stolen, a police report must be filed and the school contacted immediately. A police report will be required in order to obtain reimbursement from the district's loss fund. We will also need the parent's contact information to verify the loss and determine if this loss may be covered under a homeowner's or automobile insurance policy
