They cannot have a comma between the names, just a space.• The ST2L is just geared towards 8th graders at this time. The students in the district do not necessarily have to be involved in the grant project to use the tool.

<p>Research Updates</p>	<p>Kara Dawson and Cathy Cavanaugh</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research information is being updated on the Laptops4Learning website. • Teachers and districts overwhelmed with any requirements should know that the timeline is flexible, just contact the research team to work out alternatives for timelines. • <u>Teacher Lesson Plan System</u> – Being developed now, as an adaptation of Lessons EDU. The system ties lessons to the Technology Integration Matrix (TIM). Each teacher should submit one lesson plan. Instructions and lesson plan template can be found here. • <u>Student Digital Content System</u> – In development, will be a little longer to create, but teachers can still be gathering artifacts and keeping them locally until the system is ready. The research team will provide an instruction guide closer to the release of the system. • <u>Action Research</u> – Mentors are being assigned to districts that requested them and should be in place by October 3rd. There will be mentor “training” (more like support and discussion time for questions) the week of the 13th. See AR page for dates and times (all times EST). Presentations via podcast will be available at the website for mentors to review prior to the call. District coordinators are welcome to attend the mentor training sessions. Training information will be distributed to the mentors individually, but the research team asks that the district coordinator also send out the information to ensure it is received.
