

Cause and Effect

This activity accompanies chapter 3 from *Uncle Tom's Cabin* as told to children by Harriet Beecher Stowe, told by H.E. Marshal, record number 4858.

Activity Title: Cause and Effect

Description: The students will fill out a cause and effect chart based on the events of the chapter.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Cause and Effect

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will identify cause and effect in the chapter.

Materials:

- *Uncle Tom's Cabin*, chapter 3, available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Paper and pencils
- Cause and Effect template (below)

Procedures:

Read the third chapter of *Uncle Tom's Cabin* or have the students read it on their own. In this chapter Haley discovers that Eliza has run away with little Harry. Discuss with the students cause and effect, use examples from this chapter or previous chapters (ex: cause – Eliza found out Mr. Shelby was going to sell little Harry; effect – she decided to run away with little Harry). Have the students fill out three causes and effects that happened in this chapter on the template below.




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
