

Chronological Order

This activity accompanies chapter 4 from *Uncle Tom's Cabin* as told to children by Harriet Beecher Stowe, told by H.E. Marshal, record number 4859.

Activity Title: Chronological Order

Description: The students will fill out a chart with the sequence of main events in the story.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Chronological Order

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will identify the order of events in this chapter.

Materials:

- *Uncle Tom's Cabin*, chapter 4, available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Paper and pencils
- Chronological template (below)

Procedures:

Read the fourth chapter of *Uncle Tom's Cabin* or have the students read it on their own. Talk to the students about the main events that happened in the chapter, or have them discuss it with a partner. Next, have the students fill out the chronological template (below), with the main events of the chapter. When they are finished have them check their events with a friend.
