

Compare and Contrast

This activity accompanies chapter 6 from *Uncle Tom's Cabin* as told to children by Harriet Beecher Stowe, told by H.E. Marshal, record number 4861.

Activity Title: Compare and Contrast

Description: The students will compare and contrast how Uncle Tom and little Harry left the Shelby house.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Compare and Contrast

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will compare and contrast Uncle Tom leaving with little Harry leaving.

Materials:

- *Uncle Tom's Cabin*, chapter 6, available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Paper and pencils
- Venn diagram template (below)

Procedures:

Read the sixth chapter of *Uncle Tom's Cabin* or have the students read it on their own. Discuss with the students that both little Harry and Uncle Tom ended up leaving the Shelby's home. Have the students work with a partner to compare and contrast little Harry leaving and Uncle Tom leaving, using the Venn diagram (template below). Share the Venn diagrams with the class.



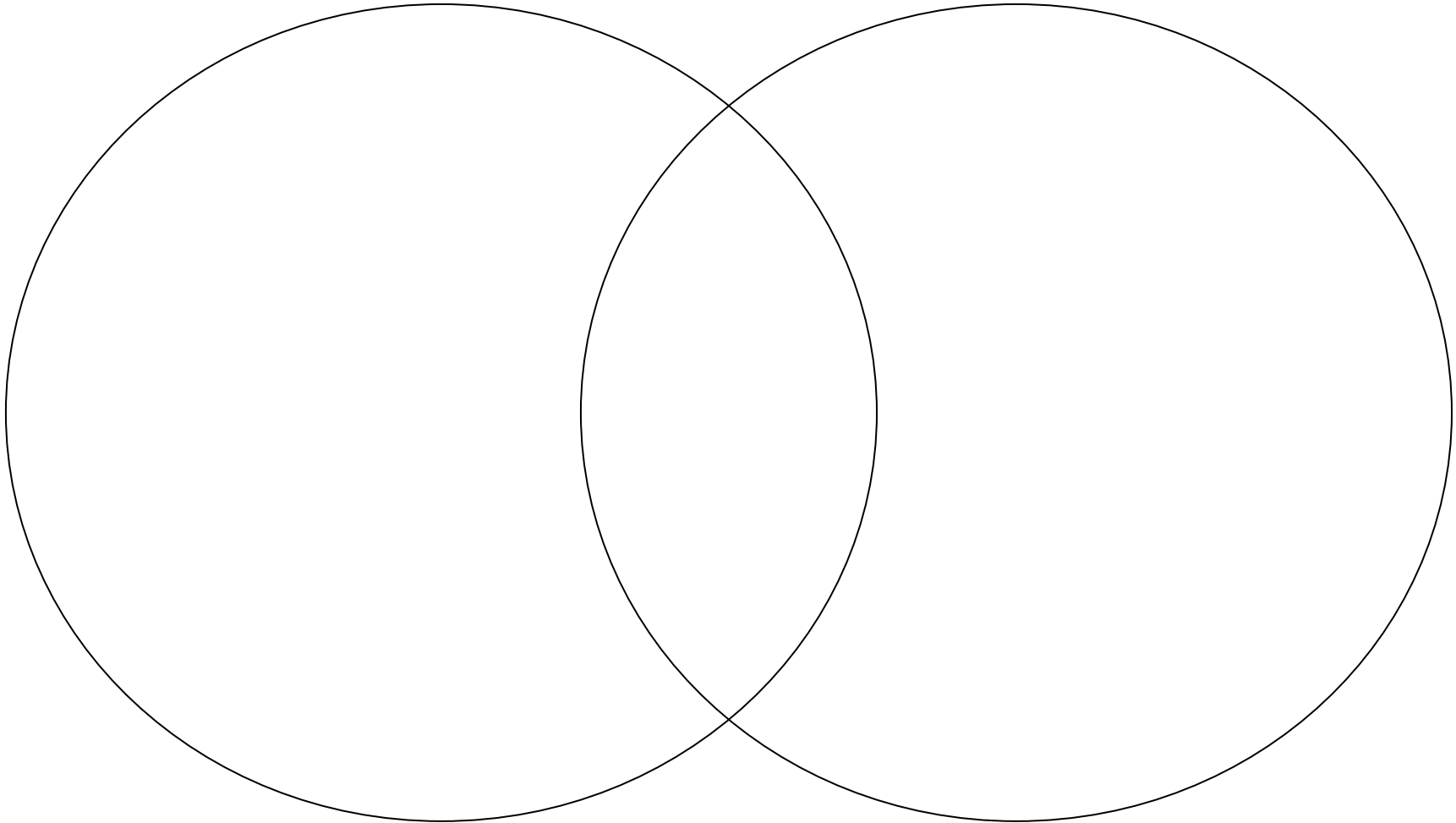
