

New Friend Advertisement

This activity accompanies chapter 8 from *Uncle Tom's Cabin* as told to children by Harriet Beecher Stowe, told by H.E. Marshal, record number 4863.

Activity Title: New Friend Advertisement

Description: The students will create a pamphlet giving instructions on how to make a new friend.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Writing

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will write instructions for how to make a new friend.

Materials:

- *Uncle Tom's Cabin*, chapter 8, available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Construction paper, colored pencils, markers, crayons, glue etc.
- Pencils and paper
- Clip art available at: <http://etc.usf.edu/clip/index.htm>

Procedures:

Read the eighth chapter of *Uncle Tom's Cabin* or have the students read it on their own. Discuss with the students how Uncle Tom becomes friends with Eva, in particular what he does to win her over. Next, have the students create a pamphlet, using construction paper, giving tips and instructions on how to make a new friend. There is an example below of the outline for a pamphlet.



Pamphlet Instructions:

Use construction paper and fold it in half hamburger style (short sides together)
