## **Travel Brochure**

This activity accompanies chapter 16 from *Up From Slavery* by Booker T. Washington, record number 4893.

**Activity Title:** Travel Brochure

**Description:** The students will create a travel brochure outlining a trip of their choice.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

**Skill:** Writing Process - Planning

## **Behavioral Objective:**

• The student will create a brochure outlining a trip of their choice.

## **Materials:**

- *Up From Slavery*, chapter 16, available in audio and print form at <a href="http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/">http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/</a>
- Pencil and paper
- Markers, crayons, colored pencils, construction paper etc.

## **Procedures:**

Read the sixteenth chapter of the book with the students, or have them read it on their own. In the sixteenth chapter of the book Washington talks about his vacation through Europe; he and his wife travel throughout Europe and meet many famous and interesting people along the way. Have the students create a brochure outlining a travel itinerary for a month long trip to anywhere in the world, at any time in history. Have the students include the people they wish to meet along the way. Share the finished brochures with the rest of the class.

As an alternative, have your students use presentation software on a computer to create an electronic travel brochure.
