Napoleon's History

This activity accompanies chapter 7 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5508.

Activity Title: Napoleon's History

Description: The students will work in small groups to research information about Napoleon.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts and Social Studies

Skill: World History and Research Skills

Behavioral Objective:

• The student will research information about Napoleon.

Materials:

- The Count of Monte Cristo, chapter 7, available in audio and print form at http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/
- Paper and pencils
- Internet access to information on Napoleon available at: http://www.pbs.org/empires/napoleon/

Procedures:

Read the chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Then, have the students work in small groups to research various parts of Napoleon's history. Allow the students time to use the internet, textbooks, or other resources to gather information. Inform the students that they will be presenting their information in front of the class when they have finished researching. Finally, when the students have had enough time to research and put together a short presentation, have each group present what they have learned.
