

Napoleon's Hundred Days

This activity accompanies chapter 13 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5514.

Activity Title: Napoleon's Hundred Days

Description: The students will work in small groups to research information about Napoleon's Hundred Days and Waterloo.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts and Social Studies

Skill: Research Skills and World History

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will research information about Napoleon's Hundred Days and Waterloo.

Materials:

- Paper and pencils
- Internet access to information on Napoleon's Hundred Days and Waterloo available at:

Procedures:

Read the chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Then, have the students work in small groups to research information on Napoleon's Hundred Days and Waterloo. Have the students use the internet (suggested websites listed above), textbooks, or other resources to perform their research. When the students have finished researching and taking notes, have a whole class discussion reviewing the information they found.
