Compare and Contrast

This activity accompanies chapter 28 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5529.

Activity Title: Compare and Contrast

Description: The students will work with a partner to compare and contrast the people who Dantes chooses to help, versus who he plans to seek revenge against.

Subject: Reading and Language Arts

Skill: Literary Analysis

Behavioral Objective:

• The student will compare and contrast the people who Dantes chooses to help, versus who he plans to seek revenge against.

Materials:

- The Count of Monte Cristo, chapter 28, available in audio and print form at http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/
- Paper and pencils

Procedures:

Read the chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Then, have the students work with a partner to write an explanation comparing and contrasting the people who Dantes chooses to help, versus those who he plans to seek revenge against. When the students have finished working, have a whole group discussion reviewing their answers.
