

## Character Map

This activity accompanies chapter 51 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5552.

**Activity Title:** Character Map

**Description:** The students will work with a partner to create a character map showing how the characters of the book are related to one another.

**Subject:** Reading and Language Arts

**Skill:** Literary Analysis

**Behavioral Objective:**

- The student will create a character map showing how the characters of the book are related to one another.

**Materials:**

- *The Count of Monte Cristo*, chapter 51 available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Paper and pencils

**Procedures:**

Read the chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Next, have the students work with a partner to create a character map depicting how the characters of the book are related to one another. Allow the students to use a format of their choice for their character map. When the students have finished working, have a whole class discussion reviewing their maps.
