

Maximilian's Horse

This activity accompanies chapter 57 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5558.

Activity Title: Maximilian's Horse

Description: The students will work with a partner to explain if Maximilian was correct in his assumptions about his horse acquirement.

Subject: Reading and Language Arts

Skill: Reading Comprehension

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will explain if Maximilian was correct in his assumptions about his horse acquirement.

Materials:

- *The Count of Monte Cristo*, chapter 57 available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Paper and pencils

Procedures:

Read the chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Next, have the students work with a partner to write an explanation describing whether or not Maximilian was correct in his assumptions about his horse acquirement. Have the students use textual support in their answers. When the students have finished working, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.
