This activity accompanies chapter 86 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5587.

Activity Title: The Trial

Description: The students will work in small groups to discuss whether or not they believe the Count of Monte Cristo was aware of Haidee's appearance at the trial of Morcerf.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Literary Analysis

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will discuss whether or not the Count of Monte Cristo was aware of Haidee's appearance at the trial of Morcerf.

Materials:

- *The Count of Monte Cristo*, chapter 86, available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Paper and pencils

Procedures:

Read the chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Then, have the students work in small groups to discuss and explain whether or not the Count of Monte Cristo was aware of Haidee's appearance at the trial of Morcerf. Have the students include textual support in their answers. When the students have finished working, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.
