## Did the Count do too much?

This activity accompanies chapter 111 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5612.

**Activity Title:** Did the Count do too much?

**Description:** The students will work in small groups to discuss and explain whether or not they believe the Count of Monte Cristo went too far with his revenge.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

**Skill:** Literary Analysis

## **Behavioral Objective:**

• The student will discuss and explain whether or not he or she believes the Count of Monte Cristo went too far with his revenge.

## **Materials:**

- The Count of Monte Cristo, chapter 111 available in audio and print form at <a href="http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/">http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/</a>
- Paper and pencils

## **Procedures:**

Read the chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Then, have the students work in small groups to discuss and explain whether or not they believe the Count of Monte Cristo went too far with his revenge. Have the students use textual support in their explanations. When the students have finished working, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.
