This activity accompanies chapter 114 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5615.

Activity Title: Albert versus Danglers

Description: The students will work in small groups to discuss and explain the similarities and differences between Albert and Danglers' captures.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Literary Analysis

Behavioral Objective:

- The student will discuss and explain the similarities and differences between Albert and Danglers' captures.

Materials:

- *The Count of Monte Cristo*, chapter 114 available in audio and print form at <http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/>
- Paper and pencils

Procedures:

Read the chapter with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Then, have the students work in small groups to discuss and explain the similarities and differences between Albert and Danglers' captures. Have the students use textual support in their explanations. When the students have finished working, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.
