Predictions for Danglers

This activity accompanies chapters 115 and 116 from *The Count of Monte Cristo* by Alexandre Dumas, record number 5617.

Activity Title: Predictions for Danglers

Description: The students will work with a partner to write predictions for what will become of Danglers after reading chapter 115, and then they will check their predictions after reading chapter 116.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Predictions

Behavioral Objective:

• The student will write predictions for what will become of Danglers after reading chapter 115, and then he or she will check the predictions after reading chapter 116.

Materials:

- The Count of Monte Cristo, chapters 115 and 116 available in audio and print form at http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/
- Paper and pencils

Procedures:

Read chapter 115 with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the chapter. Then, have the students work with a partner to write predictions for what will become of Danglers. Next, read chapter 116 with the students, or have them read it on their own. Then, have the students work with the same partners to evaluate their predictions from chapter 115, about Danglers. When the students have finished working, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.
