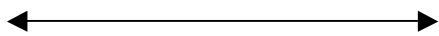
Activity:

In the reading passages, there are several instances where an inequality can be written to represent the situation. Define a variable and write an inequality for each of the following quotes.

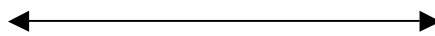
1. "The left arm of your jacket is spattered with mud in no less than seven places." Represent the number of places splattered with mud.

Solve and graph the inequality.

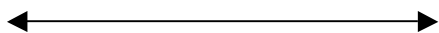
5. $x < 10$
