Mood and Meaning

Activity Title: Mood and Meaning

Description: The students will work with a partner to describe how figurative and descriptive language communicates mood and meaning in the poem.

Subject: Reading/Language Arts

Skill: Literary Analysis

Behavioral Objective:

• The student will describe how figurative and descriptive language communicates mood and meaning in the poem.

Materials:

- "At Sunset Time" poem, available in audio and print form at http://etc.usf.edu/lit2go/
- Paper and pencil

Procedures:

Read the poem with the students, or have them read it on their own. Discuss with the students the main idea of the poem. Then, have the students work with a partner to write an explanation for how the figurative and descriptive language communicates mood and meaning in the poem. When the students have finished working, have a whole class discussion reviewing their answers.
