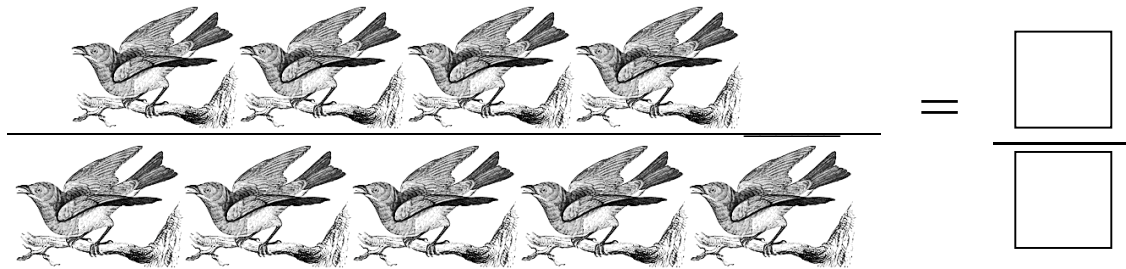

Use fractions to represent the lines in the poem.

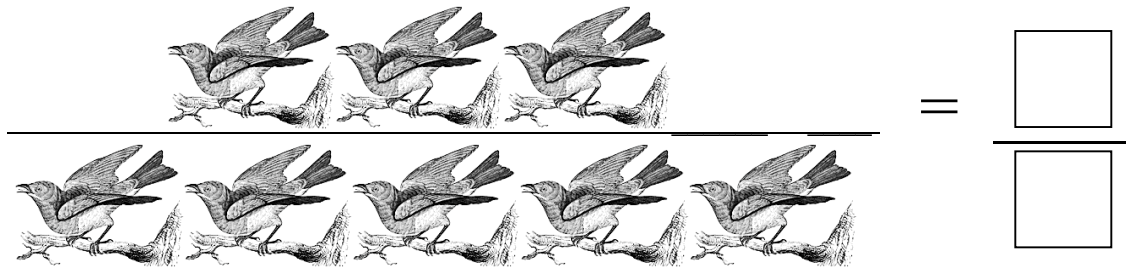
1. "Five little blue birds, hopping by my door

What fraction of birds is left?



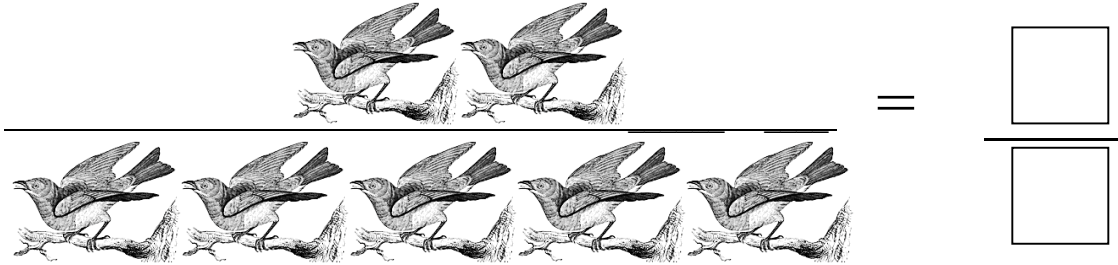
2. "Four little blue birds singing lustily

What fraction of the original 5 birds is left?



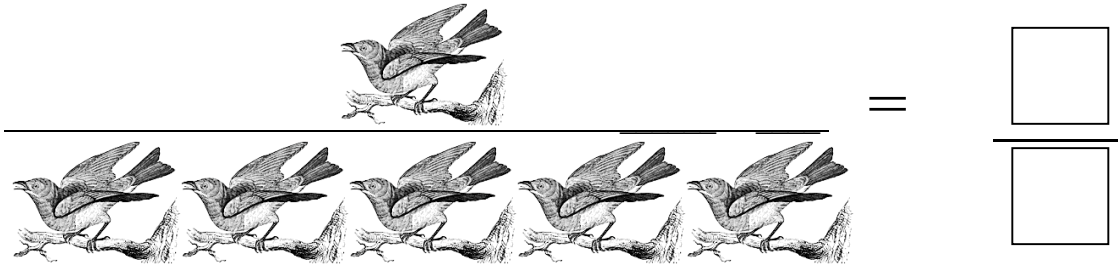
3. "Three little blue birds, and what should one do,
