Teacher Directions:

This is a good rhyme to use when teaching directionality.

- Write the rhyme on chart paper.
- Introduce it to students and repeat it a few times until students seem familiar with it.
- Clap or march the rhythm with the students as you say the rhyme.
- Ask the students how many word parts (syllables) they hear in different words.
- Choose words to add to the word wall.
- Encourage the students to memorize the rhyme. Have individual students (or pairs, if they feel more comfortable) act out the rhyme.
