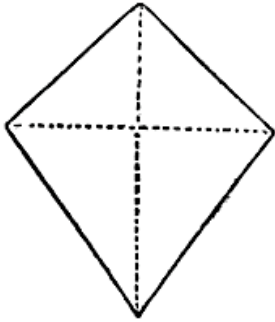

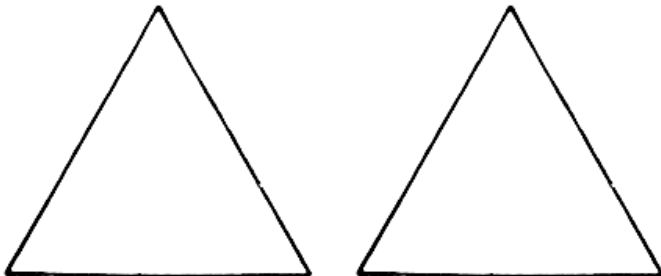
Reading Level: 2.3
