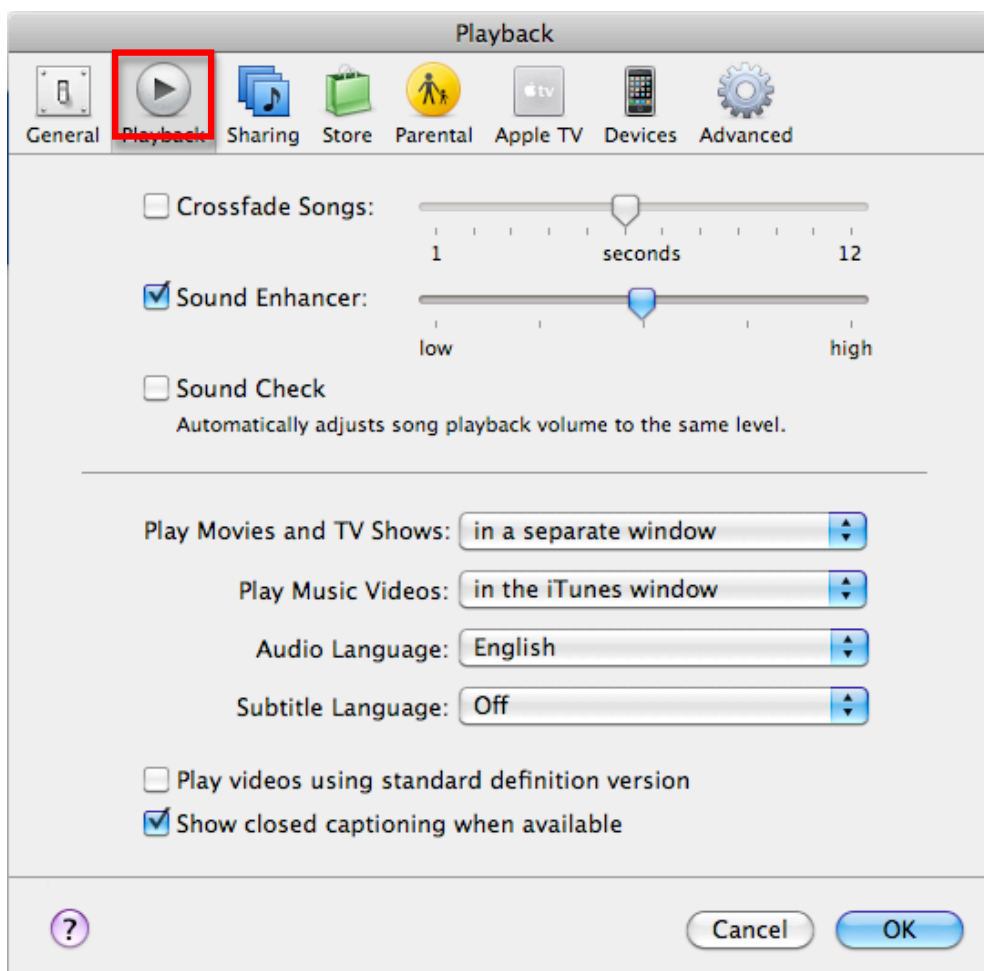

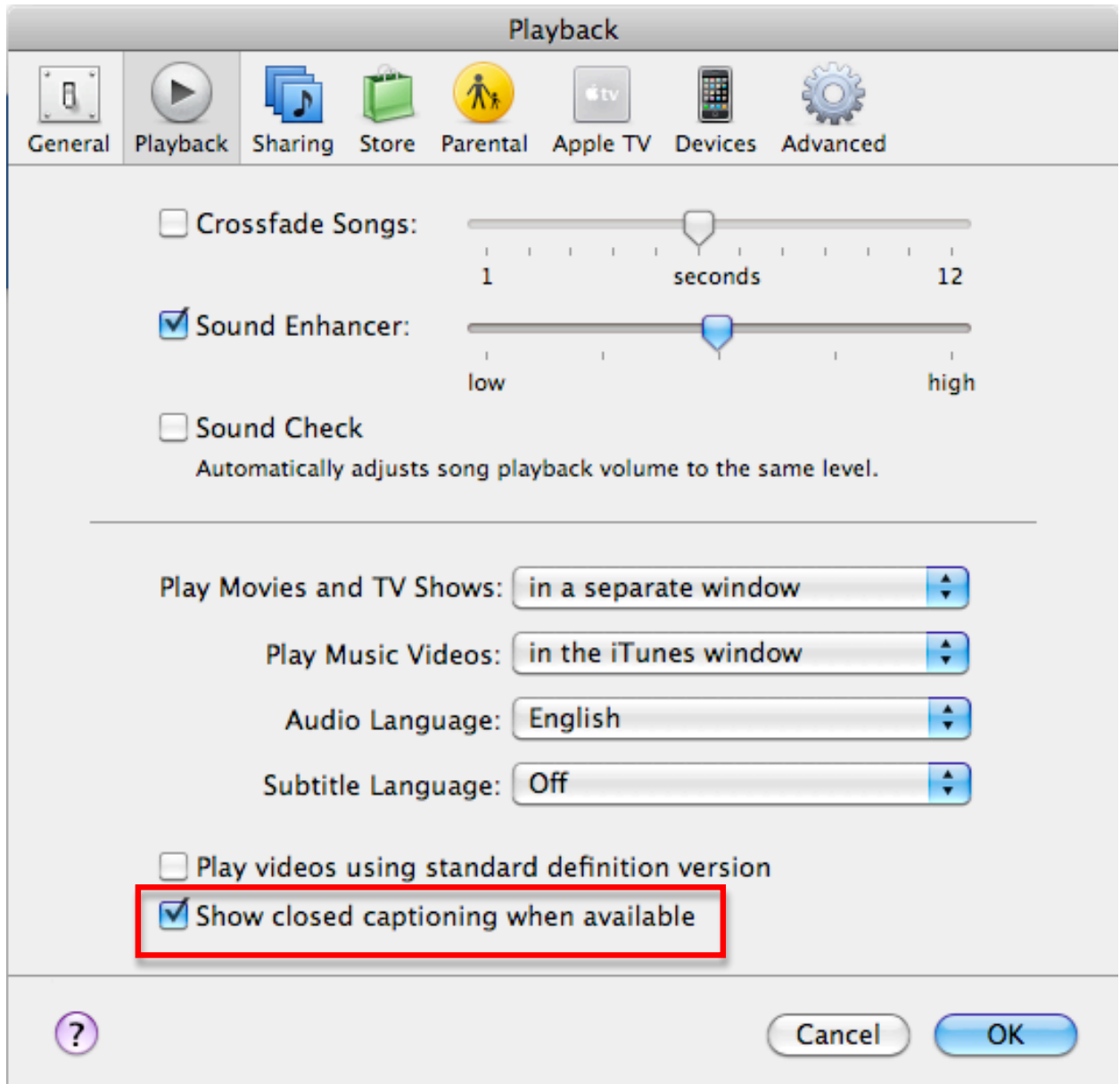
## Enabling Closed Captioning Support in iTunes

Closed captioning allows people with hearing impairments to read what is being said onscreen. To enable closed captioning in iTunes:

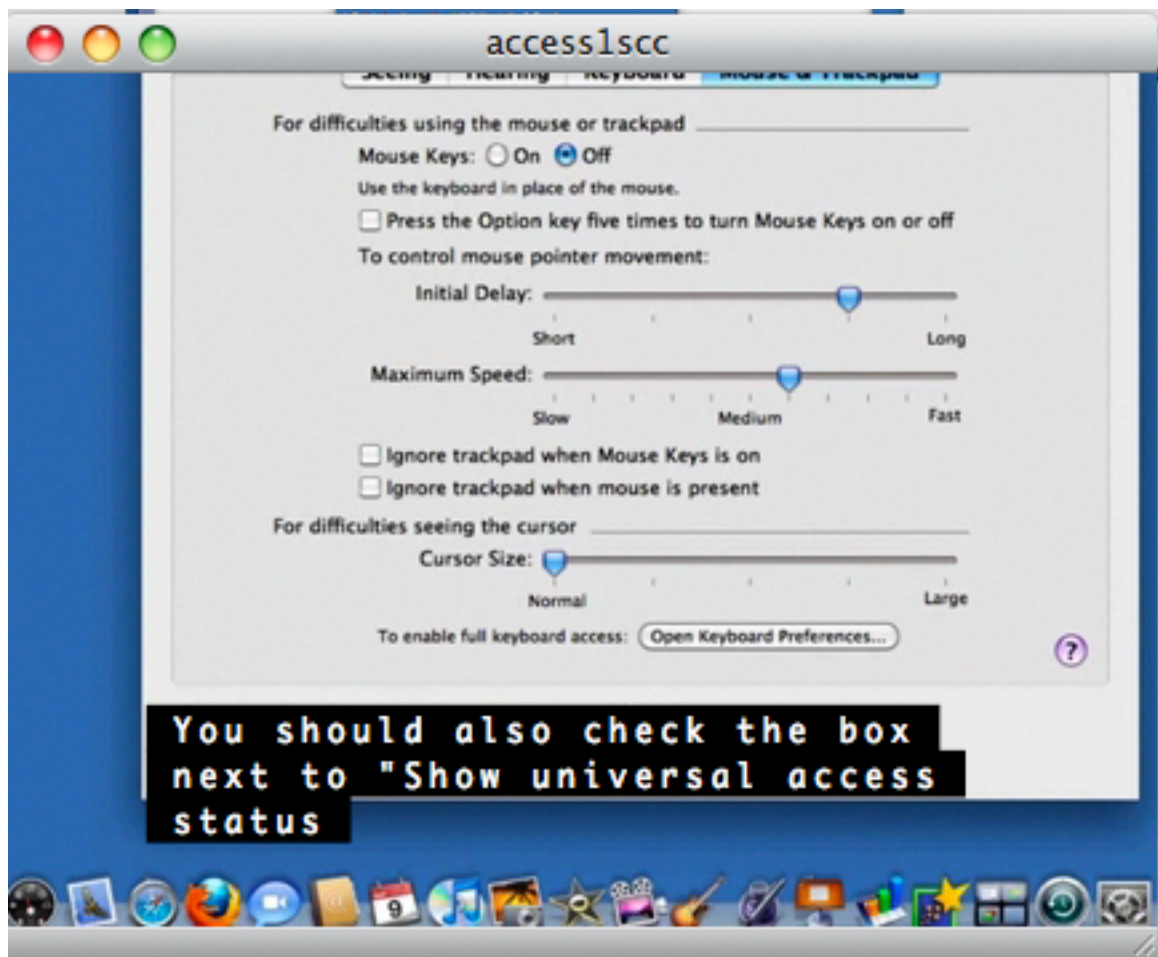
1. Launch iTunes and choose iTunes, Preferences.
2. Select the Playback pane.



3. Check the box next to “Show closed captioning when available.”



When you play a movie that is closed captioned, iTunes will display the captions on a black strip over the video.



To hide the captions, choose Controls, Audio & Subtitles, Hide Closed Captioning.
